The facility, designed with a nautical theme, encompasses 17 acres of land and offers three 25-yard lap lanes, a 150-foot inertube waterslide, tot shipwreck slide, water whoopee, water geysers and a rainbow splash pad playground. The pool, with a capacity for 459 people, includes two shade shelters and a concessions stand. Certified lifeguards provide for the safety of patrons.

The pool sits on a 37-acre park site, complete with a skate park, multi-use/soccer fields, baseball/softball field, park shelter, playground and trails.
